# **National Building Code**

The National Building Code of Canada focuses on the construction and design of new buildings as well as the renovation of existing buildings. It is developed by the National Research Council of Canada.

# Manitoba Building Code - what you need to know

Manitoba has adopted the 2010 National Building Code, through a regulation (M.R. 31/2011) of *The Buildings and Mobile Homes Act*.

# Manitoba has not adopted the 2015 National Building Code.

It is important to look at **both** the National Building Code (2010) and the regulations of *The Buildings and Mobile Homes Act* as they may need to be cross-referenced, depending on what you need to know.

**Note:** As of May, 2021, amendments made to the 2010 National Building Code of Canada *on or after December 1, 2012* have not been adopted in Manitoba.

# **Projects outside of Manitoba**

If your project is located in a different province you will need to find out which version of the National Building Code that province has adopted or adapted.
